- Date: Friday, October 19 Gates open at 4:30 pm & Saturday, October 20 Gates open at 11:30 am
 - Marketplace open until 10pm Friday & 8pm Saturday
 - KidZone open until 8:30 pm each day

- ShowClix will be the exclusive ticket provider for tickets no other advance ticket outlets are available must purchase online or at the gate. Visit showclix.com or the 'Ticket' page on the festival website
 - Tickets can be bought for either single day or a weekend bundle online
 - Weekend bundle tickets will only be available online and sales end at 3:30pm October 19 (can NOT purchase at the gate)
 - Online tickets can either be printed at home or available on a mobile device
 - Single day tickets can be purchased online and at the gate throughout the event
 - Gate purchases can be cash or credit

- There will be no "will call" option for tickets purchased online

What type of seating is available?

So that everyone can have a clear view of the stage, only blankets and grass seating will be permitted in the area directly in front of the stage. Standard lawn chairs may be used behind the rope line that will designate the blanket and grass-seating area. *No item may be left in the park overnight.*
